for sick children”**

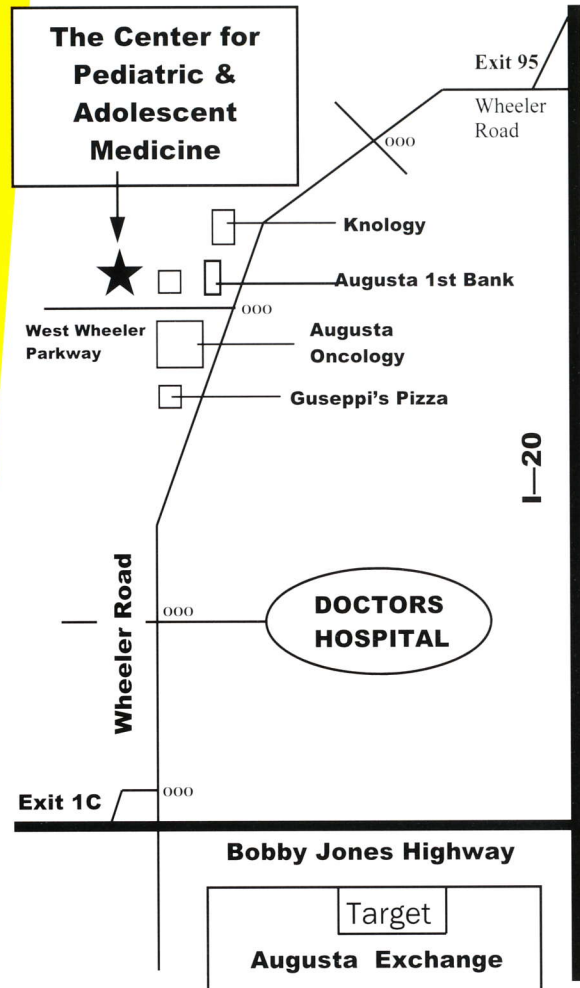
The Center for Pediatric & Adolescent Medicine offers an “After-Hours Clinic” service seven days a week, except major holidays. This is a convenient alternative to the emergency room and is open 7 pm to 9 pm weekdays and 4 pm to 7 pm on weekends in the fall and winter, and from 5 pm to 7 pm in the spring and summer. The after hours clinic operates on a first come, first served basis and is operated from the same location as our day time office. The clinic is staffed either by one of our own pediatricians or one of several other pediatricians in our call group.

Even after business hours, “The Center for Pediatric & Adolescent Medicine” continues to care for your children. We employ a registered pediatric nurse after hours to answer emergency calls about your child’s illnesses. 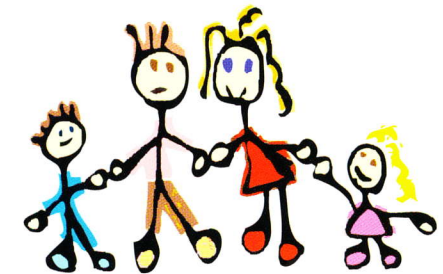

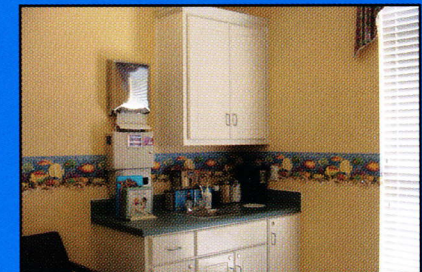
